- Youth Council of DPS Montenegro has, in February 2016 for the first time since the foundation ,became a member of an international organization , the largest youth organizations world- IUSY Social Democrats,

- Organised the VII Congress of the Youth Council of DPS Montenegro, where there were 461 delegate and over 15 foreign delegations from abroad,

- 18 June 2016 at the VII Congress of the Youth Council of DPS again was reelected president of the Youth Council of DPS Montenegro,

- At the end of July 2016. The Youth Council DPS organized and hosted the largest gathering of young leaders in the Balkans (BRT) which was first held in Montenegro,

- I was a participant in the First and Second Forum of Young Leaders 16 + 1 in Beijing, and third Forum of Young Leaders 16+1 in Bucharest.

- I was also a participant of many programs of political education in the country and abroad, as president of the largest and the largest youth organization I represented Montenegro at numerous gatherings of young leaders abroad (China, Germany, France, Bulgaria, Serbia, Albania, Portugal, Croatia, Slovenia, Rumunija, Malta, etc.).
