- 4 political youth organizations from all around the world in a single platform to work together to
- 5 change the world, but in reality there are several issues have significantly reduced IUSY's global
- 6 influence.

- 8 Transparency and accountability are two of the central issues at many international
- 9 organizations, and as we have recently seen, a lack of transparency and accountability at FIFA
- 10 has led to a major public scandal. Therefore, we believe that IUSY is at risk of becoming a futile
- 11 organization because of the major lacking of both Transparency and accountability.

- 13 In 2016, IUSY congress has adopted a resolution entitled "E-solution" after a huge debate. It
- 14 was clear during the discussion about this resolution that some of the member organizations
- 15 were not favouring this resolution, those organisations were using economic pressure against
- 16 those who voted in favour of the resolution. We also strongly believe that IUSY praesidium was
- 17 forced to hinder the implementation of "E-solution" due to economic pressure.
