- 1 Underlines that statements alone are not enough to put an end to decades of systematic Israeli
2 violations of UN Resolutions, International Humanitarian Law and the human and national
3 rights of the Palestinian people.
4
5 Israel is imposing an Apartheid regime in all of historic Palestine. The Israeli Government
6 refuses to endorse the two-state solution on the 1967 border, at the same time that it refuses
7 to grant equal rights for all the inhabitants of historic Palestine, due to its institutionalized
8 system of discrimination against non-Jewish population. The recent Likud resolution to annex
9 all of the Occupied West Bank, in addition to Occupied East Jerusalem, is an open call to go
10 from a "de-facto" into a "de jury" Apartheid regime.

12 At the same time, we are utterly concerned by the racist trends in the Israeli Knesset, including
13 the racist amendment to the Israeli Citizenship Law, approved with the votes of the Israeli right-
14 wing government with the support of the Israeli Labor Party and rejected by Meretz and the
15 Joint Arab List, that prevents thousands of Palestinian citizens from obtaining family
16 reunification only because they are not Jews.

18 We strongly condemn the statements the new leader of the Israeli Labor Party, who did not
19 only publicly state that he does not care about the rights of the Palestinian people, but who
20 also presented support for illegal Israeli colonial-settlements in Occupied Palestine, the
21 annexation of Occupied East Jerusalem, capital of the State of Palestine as well going to the

22 extent of using bigotry against the rights of the Palestinian people by stating that “the Land of
23 Israel belongs to the Jews, God promised it to Abraham”. We firmly state that the use of
24 religion for political purposes has no place in the Social Democratic family.

26 **We salute the efforts of progressive sectors within Israel, including civil society groups such**
27 **as Btselem and Breaking the Silence, that have been targets of vicious attacks and**
28 **persecution from the current Israeli government. At the same time we denounces threats**
29 **against Palestinian civil society groups, particularly Al Haq, for their involvement with the**
30 **International Criminal Court. We also condemn the difficulties imposed by Israel against the**
31 **work of international human rights organizations such as Amnesty International and Human**
32 **Rights Watch.**

34 The decision of the U.S. President Donald Trump to recognize Jerusalem as Israel’s capital is a
35 violation of UNSC Resolution 478. It is also an insult to millions of Palestinians and a direct
36 attack against the two-state solution. We condemn this decision, declare that Jerusalem must
37 be the capital of two-states, and call upon everyone to recognize the State of Palestine on the
38 1967 border with East Jerusalem as its capital.

40 As we continue to work for the two-state solution, we recognize that trends on the ground are
41 strengthening the current situation of a one-state reality with two different systems. An
42 Apartheid regime that we shall never tolerate. The International Community must make use of
43 all its diplomatic, political and popular non-violent tools in order to put an end to this current
44 reality. It should be clear that based on our Social Democratic values we have the duty to fight
45 Apartheid. We tell the Israeli government: the only alternative to a two-state solution on the
46 1967 border is one single state with equal rights. IUSY would be willing to support any of those
47 solutions in order to grant equality, dignity, freedom and justice for everyone, Palestinians and
48 Israelis, Christians, Muslims and Jews.

50 As we are about to mark 70 years since the creation of Israel, known in Palestine as the Nakba,
51 it is long overdue time for the Palestinian people to enjoy its inalienable rights. Therefore we
52 call upon our members organizations to:
53

- 54 1) To put pressure on governments to recognize the State of Palestine on the 1967
55 border with East Jerusalem as its capital.
- 56 2) To divest from all companies involved in human rights violations in the Occupied
57 State of Palestine, including all companies that profit from the Israeli occupation.
- 58 3) To call upon governments to enforce existing laws to prevent the Israeli
59 occupation from making any economic benefits. Banning Israeli colonial-
60 settlement products is a legal, political and moral responsibility for everyone who
61 supports the two-state solution on the 1967 border.

- 4) To include in all official visits to Israel meetings with representatives from the Palestinian citizens of the state as well as with Israeli Human Rights Organizations persecuted by the state, including Breaking the Silence and Btselem.
 - 5) To include in all official visits to Palestine meetings in East Jerusalem with Palestinian representatives.
 - 6) To reject all attempts at normalizing the Israeli occupation of Palestine, including by meetings with Israeli representatives in the territory occupied in 1967 or by engaging in programs with Israeli counterparts that don't specify the 1967 border as the only internationalized recognized border of the State of Israel.
