- 1 Article 22 of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights in Paris already enshrines the
- 2 right of every person to social security, yet it is necessary to note that approximately
- 3 80% of the world population has no or little access to social security.
- 4
- 5 As young socialists from a multitude of horizons and from all continents, we must note
- 6 that the international community and the different national communities of our
- 7 globalized planet are not committed to the effective guarantee of economic, social, and
- 8 cultural rights of their most vulnerable citizens.

- 10 While the fight against climate change must intensify and its consequences
- 11 disproportionately affect individuals and national communities historically most affected
- 12 by colonialism, sexism, racism and other discrimination, historical consequences of our
- 13 model of society capitalist and patriarchal;

15 While we want to engage sincerely and truly for the achievement of the Sustainable  
16 Development Goals;

18 We Young Socialists of IUSY proclaim and defend that it is a priority:

19

20 - **to solve the major problem of fiscal injustice.**

21 The measures defended directly by IUSY in its campaign against tax evasion,  
22 but also by many civil society actors are the main way to solve this problem.  
23 Fiscal injustice is proof that, beyond the notable differences between Globalized  
24 North and Globalized South, we live in a poorly developed world, where wealth is  
25 concentrated more and more on a small number while the greater part of the  
26 world's population is deprived of its fundamental rights.

27

28 - **to increase directly and immediately the resources made available by the  
29 international community for public goods and services all over the world  
30 and particularly in the Globalized South.**

31 It is only through a network of public services of proximities that the situation of  
32 the most precarious and most vulnerable people can be really transformed and  
33 that we will be able to stem the social downgrading, put an end to the most  
34 flagrant injustices and to offer everyone the opportunity to exercise their most  
35 basic rights.

36

37 - **to reinforce in each national and international community the presence and  
38 action of trade unions and mutuals, as well as directly and jointly with  
39 public authorities in the management, construction and strengthening of  
40 the social protection model.**

41 Mutuals and trade unions, as bodies representing young and old, people in social

42 and medical difficulties, the precarious, the overexploited, those looking for jobs  
43 or inability to exercise one, are irreplaceable partners in a social protection  
44 system that takes into account the needs of the weakest. A society without  
45 strong trade unions and mutuals can not really achieve the Sustainable  
46 Development Goals and even less allow the individuals that compose it to  
47 emancipate themselves.

48  
49 All human beings are born free and equal in rights, but the material and immaterial  
50 conditions of life in which these births take place put a direct end to this theoretical  
51 equality. Only by working boldly to develop models of social security that can be  
52 financed and adapted to the reality of each community we will be able to achieve what  
53 is both a utopia and a foundation of international law for which each and every one of  
54 them should campaign. .

55  
56 IUSY will join forces with progressive forces around the world who are already working  
57 on the subject by developing, in cooperation with them, its own expertise, campaigns  
58 and workshops to inform, raise awareness and convince political leaders.

60 We strongly urge all leftist progressive forces to do the same!
