1	We Francophone activists of IUSY, members of various and united organizations, affirm our
2	solidarity and our common struggle for democracy, human rights and social rights.
4	We recognize that the struggle for democracy, human rights and social rights is a continuing
5	struggle that is still relevant today in our countries. We recognize that this struggle brings us
6	together in an international and internationalist community and creates a solidarity of
7	struggle across borders, governments and languages.
9	The place of the Francophonie in the world, though coming from a colonial heritage and a
10	postcolonial practice, reflects a common culture and language that allows us to better take
11	into account each country and allows everyone of our activists to raise their voice and to
12	have a place at the table of decisions.
13	We are committed to guaranteeing each of our activists and each of our organizations a place
14	in the global political debate, and we wish to work for a more just and egalitarian world. We
15	are fighting the current capitalist system, which locks us into an unequal blackmail between
16	rich and developing countries, and which builds a de facto inequality through the
17	confiscation and exploitation of raw materials and natural resources, which every day
18	endanger the environmental, social and democratic integrity of some of our countries.
20	We reaffirm the need for our organization to defend the place of the French language and to
21	allow each of our organizations and activists to be fully involved in IUSY. We wish to
22	undertake the construction of common positions and to fight this fight in a collective and
23	common way in order to make it possible to benefit from this culture and to make it a tool
24	for the human rights and the workers, for the access to each one of vital rights like the right
25	to health, housing, ecology, good working conditions and a democratic and legal political
26	system. We condemn the violations of human rights, social rights and democracy in our
27	countries, and we stand together in the fight against oppression and intolerance.
