A just global economy must be built on dignity, equality, and solidarity, not exploitation. Yet around the world, millions of workers still face unsafe conditions, poverty wages, precarious contracts, and attacks on their right to organise. It is time to establish a global floor of labour protections that no country, corporation, or institution is allowed to fall beneath.

This includes living wages, safe workplaces, limits on working hours, and access to social protections anchored in the most progressive labour frameworks available today. But it also requires the active protection and promotion of trade unions, which remain the most powerful force for defending workers' rights. In far too many places, union leaders face harassment, criminalisation, and even violence.

It's time to call on the international community to ensure that workers everywhere have the right to organise, bargain collectively, and strike without fear. Strong unions and fair labour standards are not only essential for economic justice. They are essential for democracy itself.

Therefore, we propose that:

- IUSY calls for a global baseline of working conditions and minimum standards equivalent to those upheld in the most progressive labour frameworks.
- IUSY calls for workers' rights and the role of trade unions to be clearly protected and promoted at the international level.
