The Islamic Republic of Iran has demonstrated a persistent pattern of oppression, injustice, and human rights violations against its own citizens. Iran's regime has repeatedly shown an inability to coexist peacefully with neighboring states and the international community. Furthermore, Iran has employed missile technology to conduct attacks resulting in civilian casualties, including children, demonstrating a disregard for international humanitarian law, while continuing to engage in destabilizing activities throughout the Middle East region through proxy forces and direct military action. A regime that demonstrates such aggressive behavior domestically and regionally poses an exceptional threat should not be allowed to acquire nuclear weapons.

This resolution acknowledges that:

- The Islamic Republic of Iran has established a clear record of oppressive governance characterized by systematic human rights abuses, persecution of minorities, suppression of political dissent, and denial of fundamental freedoms;
- Iran has repeatedly chosen conflict over cooperation, as evidenced by its support for non-state armed groups, interference in neighboring countries' affairs, and provocative military actions;
- The use of ballistic missiles by Iran against civilian targets, resulting in the deaths of innocent children, demonstrates a willingness to employ indiscriminate violence to achieve political objectives;
- Iran's pattern of regional destabilization, including actions in Syria, Iraq, Yemen, Lebanon, and elsewhere, reveals a strategic doctrine incompatible with responsible nuclear stewardship;
- A regime that deliberately targets civilians, including children, with conventional weapons cannot be trusted to exercise appropriate restraint regarding nuclear capabilities;



- The acquisition of nuclear weapons by the current Iranian regime would dramatically escalate regional tensions, potentially trigger a nuclear arms race, and increase the risk of nuclear material falling into the hands of non-state actors;

Therefore, this resolution:

- Affirms that the prevention of nuclear weapons acquisition by the Islamic Republic of Iran represents an urgent international security priority;
- Declares that Iran's demonstrated behavior—including its use of missiles against civilian populations, its support for armed proxy groups, and its regional destabilization efforts—fundamentally disqualifies it from being trusted with nuclear weapons capability
- Rejects the notion that a regime willing to kill children with conventional weapons and missiles could be relied upon to exercise responsible stewardship of nuclear weapons;
- Calls for comprehensive, verifiable, and permanent measures to ensure Iran cannot develop or acquire nuclear weapons technology;
- Support diplomatic initiatives aimed at constraining Iran's nuclear program while maintaining robust verification mechanisms;
- Urges the international community to maintain vigilance against clandestine nuclear development activities by Iran;
- Recommends continued technological cooperation to detect and prevent illicit procurement networks that could support nuclear weapons development;
- Emphasizes that peaceful coexistence in the Middle East requires Iran to abandon both its nuclear weapons ambitions and its strategy of regional destabilization
- Recognizes that genuine security and prosperity for the Iranian people can only be achieved through change regime.
