1.Dear member organizations,

2.After the war in Gaza stopped following an agreement between Hamas and Israel — which 3.included a ceasefire, the release of hostages in phases, and the start of negotiations over the 4.future of Gaza — Israel broke the deal. Despite releasing some hostages, it violated the 5.internationally-backed truce and resumed its military operations, ignoring the agreement 6.brokered by Egypt, Qatar, and supported by the United States.

7.Hamas, for its part, respected the agreement and continued to abide by it for a period, even after 8.Israel returned to the battlefield. This clearly shows that Israel alone broke the deal. But Israel 9.didn't just go back to war — it also blocked the entry of humanitarian aid into Gaza.

10. This war has caused the death of tens of thousands of people and left many others severely 11. injured or disabled. It has led to famine, the spread of deadly diseases, and the destruction of 12. hospitals and homes. More than two million Palestinians were forcibly displaced. Many others 13. were arrested and tortured in Israeli prisons. All these actions are serious violations of human 14. rights and of a people's right to self-determination.

15. The Progressive Youth Organization strongly condemns the systematic attacks carried out by 16. Israel, which amount to genocide and crimes against humanity in Gaza — as well as in the 17. West Bank, where Palestinians face constant violence and land theft through Israeli settlement 18. plans.

19. The Progressive Youth Organization reaffirms its historic and unwavering support for the 20. Palestinian cause, for the right of the Palestinian people to live with dignity on their land, and

for 21.their right to decide their own future. We call for all forms of support — public, political, and 22.diplomatic — and demand serious, effective action, not just symbolic words.

23.We demand clear international condemnation of Israel's actions, pressure to stop the war, allow 24.humanitarian aid into the besieged Gaza Strip, end the attacks, and move toward a real two-25.state solution — the only just, realistic, and achievable path supported by the Arab world.

26. This is not just about Palestine. It's a matter of global conscience. If the world allows Israel to 27. kill tens of thousands of people without real consequences, it opens the door for such crimes to 28. happen elsewhere. That's why we must unite, speak out, and pressure governments to take real action in every international forum.
