1. The International Union of Socialist Youth (IUSY) reaffirm its
2. historic role in standing with oppressed people, especially youth,
3. in their struggle for freedom, dignity, and justice. Education is not
4. a privilege granted by power; it is a right. When education is
5. targeted, it is not collateral damage, it is a deliberate political act
6. aimed at controlling the future of people.
7. In the occupied Palestinian territories, particularly in the West
8. bank and the Gaza Strip, Palestinian students are systematically
9. denied their right to education through military violence, siege,
10. and structural repression. In the West Bank, Israeli occupation
11. forces repeatedly invade Palestinian university campuses, storm
12. lecture halls and dormitories, arrest students and student leaders,
13. and use intimidation and force inside academic spaces. These
14. actions terrorize students, disrupt academic life, and criminalize
15. political and student organizing, turning universities into sites of
16. military control rather than spaces of learning.
17. In Gaza, the situation is even more extreme. The genocide against



18. the Gaza Strip has led to the destruction of every university and  
19. thousands of schools. Students and educators have been killed,  
20. academic infrastructure has been erased, and more than two full  
21. academic years have been lost. Education in Gaza has not simply  
22. been interrupted, it has been deliberately destroyed. The ongoing  
23. siege, mass displacement, psychological trauma, famine, and  
24. lack of basic services continue to make education impossible,  
25. even beyond active military bombardment.

26. IUSY recognizes that the invasion of university campuses in the  
27. West Bank and the destruction of education in Gaza is part of a  
28. single, coordinated policy. This policy aims to break Palestinian  
29. society by targeting its students, its institutions, and its future. This  
30. practice constitutes terrorizing students, the use of fear, violence,  
31. and destruction to suppress education, critical thought, and  
32. collective resistance.

33. IUSY condemns the targeting of educational institutions, students,  
34. and educators in all forms. The militarization of campuses, the  
35. destruction of schools and universities, and the terrorization of  
36. students are serious violations of international law and an attack  
37. on the right of an entire generation to learn, organize, and live with  
38. dignity. IUSY stands in full solidarity with Palestinian students in  
39. Gaza and the West Bank and with all students facing repression  
40. under occupation and war.

41. Therefore, IUSY resolves:

42. To recognize the systematic targeting of Palestinian education as  
43. a terrorizing act and a grave violation of international law and  
44. human rights.

45. To condemn Israeli military invasions of Palestinian university  
46. campuses in the West Bank, including arrests, harassment, and  
47. the use of force against students, faculty, and academic spaces.

48. To acknowledge the ongoing impact of the genocide in Gaza on



- 49.education, including the destruction of all higher education
- 50.institutions and the loss of multiple academic years for an entire
51. generation of students.
- 52.To call on international institutions to take immediate and
- 53.concrete measures to protect education in Palestine, in line with
- 54.international humanitarian law and the Safe Schools Declaration.
- 55.To urge IUSY member organizations to actively support
- 56.Palestinian students, through academic solidarity, psychological
- 57.support, advocacy for detained students, and sustained pressure
- 58.against the militarization and targeting of education.
- 59.To reaffirm IUSY's commitment to justice, peace, and the universal
- 60.right to education, and to oppose occupation, apartheid, and
61. colonial policies that deny youth their future.
- 62.IUSY affirms that there is no freedom without education and no
- 63.peace without justice. Standing against systematic targeting
- 64.and militarization of education under occupation is not
- 65.symbolic, it is a political and moral responsibility that defines
- 66.who we are an international youth movement.
