4 **Whereas**, Nepal Tarun Dal, the youth wing of the Nepali Congress, is firmly committed
5 to democracy, human rights, social justice, and active participation in the democratic
6 process;

7 **Whereas**, Nepal Tarun Dal plays a vital role in promoting democratic values,
8 mobilizing youth, encouraging leadership, advocating for good governance,
9 transparency, and accountability, and supporting free and fair elections;

10 **Whereas**, the Gen Z protest that began on September 8, 2025, emerged as a youth-led
11 movement demanding accountability, an end to corruption and elite impunity, and a
12 more just and equitable society;

13 **Whereas**, the protests escalated into violence following excessive use of force by
14 security agencies, resulting in the deaths of at least 77 people, including schoolchildren,
15 injuries to hundreds, and widespread destruction of public and private property;

16 **Whereas**, the political unrest led to the resignation of Prime Minister K.P. Sharma Oli
17 and the appointment of Sushila Karki as Interim Prime Minister, who introduced relief
18 and austerity measures to address the damage caused;

19 **Whereas**, during the protests, Nepali Congress Party President Sher Bahadur Deuba
20 and his wife Arju Rana Deuba were injured in an attack on their residence, an act
21 strongly condemned by Nepal Tarun Dal, the Nepali Congress, and the Socialist
22 International;

23 **Whereas**, Sher Bahadur Deuba has significantly contributed to the global democratic
24 movement through his leadership roles in the Socialist International;

25 **Whereas**, Nepal Tarun Dal demonstrated its humanitarian commitment by constructing
26 72 temporary shelters for earthquake-affected families in Jajarkot and Rukum West
27 following the devastating earthquake of November 3, 2023;

28 **Whereas**, Nepal experienced major political, social, and natural challenges in 2025,
29 including youth protests, government transition, recurring natural disasters, and
30 preparations for elections scheduled for March 5, 2026;

- 31 **Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved**, that Nepal Tarun Dal reaffirms its unwavering
32 commitment to democracy, peaceful political engagement, and constitutional
33 governance;
- 34 **Be It Further Resolved**, that Nepal Tarun Dal acknowledges the legitimate aspirations
35 of Nepal's youth and calls for inclusive dialogue and democratic reforms to address
36 corruption, inequality, and governance failures;
- 37 **Be It Further Resolved**, that Nepal Tarun Dal condemns all forms of violence,
38 including excessive use of force and attacks on political leaders, civilians, and property;
- 39 **Be It Further Resolved**, that Nepal Tarun Dal demands accountability and justice for
40 victims of the 2025 unrest through independent and transparent investigations;
- 41 **Be It Further Resolved**, that Nepal Tarun Dal expresses solidarity with democratic
42 forces nationally and internationally and supports free, fair, and peaceful elections;
- 43 **Be It Finally Resolved**, that Nepal Tarun Dal remains committed to youth
44 empowerment, democratic renewal, humanitarian service, and the long-term stability
45 and progress of Nepal.
