The International Union of Socialist Youth (IUSY) expresses its deep concern about the current situation of youth employability in Mexico.

According to data from the National Institute of Statistics and Geography (INEGI), almost half of Generation Z in the country (people aged 15 to 29 ) is

unemployed, with young women facing higher levels of

11

impact.

Poor economic management, financial irresponsibility, clientelist policies,

13

high levels of corruption, legal uncertainty, and the absence of adequate regulations

14

adequate regulations for new disruptive technologies—such as artificial intelligence—

15

generate low levels of investment public and private. This translates into

16

limited job opportunities, especially for Mexican youth.

17

Under the right conditions, public and private investment can increase

18

employment opportunities and open up prospects for a dignified life for young people in

19

Mexico.

20

Likewise, persistently low public investment in the education sector caused a

21

decline of 6.6% in productivity between 2018 and 2024, according to INEGI.

22

deepening the economic and employment crisis facing young people. The decline in

23

productivity also makes recent positive advances in labor policy—such as the

24

recent positive advances in labor policy—such as the progressive reduction of

25

the working week from 48 to 40 hours—given that historically Mexico has

26

compensated for its low productivity with a high volume of hours worked, a

27

strategy that is becoming increasingly unsustainable in the face of these changes and

28

demographic transformations.

29

In this regard, education and training are essential for boosting

30

productivity, expand the economic opportunities and ensure better

31

working conditions.

32 Therefore, IUSY urgently calls for:

- 33 ● Strengthen the actors responsible for public policies, companies,  
34 unions, and educational institutions, with the aim of creating  
35 Decent and productive working conditions.
- 36 ● Establish mandatory training for key political, economic, and social actors  
37 on labor policies, incorporating gender and youth approaches  
38 youth in employment, from recruitment processes to  
39 working conditions and lifelong learning.
- 40 ● Act as a coordinator of coalitions that connect political,  
41 economic, and social actors who share these values and seek to promote  
42 youth employability, decent work, and education and training (for  
43 example, through the organization of a summit international of  
44 youth on work and employment in Mexico City).
- 45 ● Maintain an ongoing commitment to observing and monitoring  
46 labor and education policies (including legislation, curricula, and  
47 mechanisms for intersectoral collaboration).

48 IUSY reaffirms that there can be no full economic development without decent work  
49 decent work, education, and training.
