1. In February 2025, the Progressive Youth Organization launched, in the  
 2. presence of the President of the Progressive Socialist Party, a political  
 3. document addressing political and youth-related issues, in which it  
 4. emphasized e-governance as a central reform for building a fair,  
 5. accountable, and socially just state.

6. Lebanon’s crisis is not only economic but structural, reflecting the collapse  
 7. of public institutions under corruption, clientelism, and unequal access to  
 8. power and resources. These practices stand in direct contradiction to  
 9. socialist principles, which uphold equality before the law, the protection of  
 10. the public good, and the responsibility of the state to serve all citizens  
 11. without discrimination.

12. E-governance represents a modern expression of socialist values in public  
 13. administration. By eliminating discretionary power, limiting personal  
 14. mediation, and making procedures transparent and traceable, e-  
 15. governance dismantles clientelist networks that benefit the few at the  
 16. expense of the many. It guarantees equal access to public services,  
 17. protects social rights, and restores the role of the state as a fair regulator  
 18. rather than a gatekeeper of privileges.



19.This resolution demands the immediate adoption of a binding national e-  
20.governance framework applicable to all ministries, public institutions,  
21.and municipalities, ensuring the full digitization of public services,  
22.administrative procedures, and public procurement in the interest of  
23.equality and social justice. It further demands the public disclosure of all  
24.tenders, contracts, budgets, and expenditures through unified digital  
25.platforms, affirming the socialist principle that public resources belong to  
26.the people and must be managed in full transparency.

27.It also demands the establishment of secure digital identity systems,  
28.strong cybersecurity safeguards, and independent oversight mechanisms  
29.to protect citizens' data while enforcing accountability and collective  
30.responsibility. Municipalities must be empowered to implement e-  
31.governance as a tool for participatory governance, local development, and  
32.the democratization of decision-making.

33.ISUY calls on all countries that have successfully implemented e-  
34.governance to support Lebanon by sharing their expertise and transferring  
35.their institutional experience. E-governance must be measured by its  
36.impact on people's lives: the reduction of corruption, the dismantling of  
37.patronage, equal access to services, and the strengthening of public trust.  
38.From a socialist perspective, this reform is not optional but essential to  
39.rebuilding a state that serves society rather than entrenched interests. E-  
40.governance is not a technical upgrade but a political choice. For Lebanon  
41.to move toward social justice and institutional renewal, e-governance  
42.must be adopted now as a non-negotiable socialist reform.
