IUSY stands in unwavering solidarity with the Palestinian people in the face of the brutal and ongoing genocide in Gaza.

Israel's colonial project is rooted in Zionism, an ethno-nationalist ideology that has built a system of racial apartheid on stolen Palestinian land. For over 75 years, Palestinians have suffered dispossession, occupation, forced displacement, and apartheid under a regime that systematically privileges one ethno-national group at the direct expense of another. Today's atrocities in Gaza are not isolated events, but the latest chapter in a long, violent history of colonialism.

The war waged by Israel against Gaza since October 2023 must be recognized as a deliberate act of genocide and mass war crimes against civilians. Israel invokes the pretext of "self-defense" to justify an unrelenting campaign of destruction and death, while the reality on the ground exposes a systematic assault aimed at the annihilation of Palestinian life. The entire fabric of civilian life has been targeted: hospitals reduced to rubble, schools obliterated, universities bombed, and the infrastructure needed for water, electricity, and basic survival deliberately destroyed.

Israeli leaders across the political spectrum, from right to left, have employed openly genocidal and eliminationist rhetoric. They have referred to Palestinians as "human animals" and have invoked biblical calls for total destruction, exposing the fascist and colonial nature of this war. Such language is not rhetoric alone, it is a roadmap to the total erasure of Gaza's people.

Israel has weaponized essential human needs, such as food, water, fuel, and humanitarian aid, while using starvation as a tool of war. Gaza's health system has collapsed under relentless attack; famine is now widespread, implemented by Israeli siege policies that deny even the most basic aid to civilians. Gaza has been turned into a living graveyard, where survival itself is resistance.

The human cost of this aggression is catastrophic. Over 51,000 Palestinians have been killed, over 16,000 of them children. More than 117,000 have been injured. Nearly 10,000 remain missing under the rubble. Almost 2 million people, nearly the entire population have been displaced, forced to flee their homes under constant bombardment.

Israel's actions are not merely acts of war; they are part of a strategy to render Gaza permanently unlivable, to create new demographic reality and to force Palestinians into a second Nakba, known as mass displacement outside their homeland. Israeli leaders openly discuss plans to expel Gaza's people, completing the historic injustice that began with the Nakba of 1948.

The International Criminal Court's decision to issue arrest warrants for the Israeli Prime Minister and Defense Minister marks a historic step toward justice. IUSY reaffirms its respect for the Rome Statute and the primacy of international law. We condemn the reception of indicted Israeli officials on European soil and the use of European airspace by individuals charged with genocide and war crimes. Such actions directly contradict the obligations of the international community and undermine the credibility of global justice.

IUSY denounces the shameless double standards of many Western governments, which have failed to act against Israel's crimes while promoting accountability elsewhere. We condemn the complicity of the Trump administration and others who have enabled, armed, and justified this genocide.

It is clear that Israel has moved from managing the conflict to trying to resolve it permanently by force, through the colonial domination of Gaza, the West Bank, and historic Palestine. This must not succeed. We must resist any narrative that erases Palestinian rights or justifies their ongoing dispossession.

IUSY calls for an immediate and unconditional ceasefire, the lifting of the siege on Gaza, and the full restoration of humanitarian aid. We demand a just and comprehensive solution based on international law, guaranteeing the Palestinian people's right to self-determination, return, freedom, and full sovereignty in an independent Palestinian state.

We welcome the courageous steps of countries that have recognized the State of Palestine and urge all others to do the same, standing firmly against Zionist colonial narratives and affirming the Palestinian right to freedom, justice, dignity and sovereignty.
