The International Union of Socialist Youth (IUSY) reiterates its historic role in standing alongside oppressed people, particularly youth, in their struggle for freedom, dignity, and education. As war and occupation continue to devastate communities around the globe, students are among the most vulnerable—facing interrupted education, psychological trauma, displacement, and at times, targeted violence.

In the occupied Palestinian territories, particularly Gaza and the West Bank, thousands of students are systematically denied their right to education due to military aggression, siege, and the structural violence of occupation. University campuses are bombed, students and faculty are arbitrarily detained, and movement restrictions make access to classrooms and exams nearly impossible. The siege on Gaza has destroyed schools and universities, and ongoing military incursions in the West Bank, including refugee camps like Jenin and cities like Nablus and Tulkarm, continue to threaten students' safety and academic futures.

IUSY condemns all attacks on educational institutions and the targeting of students in conflict zones. The deliberate destruction of education is a violation of international law and an assault on the future of every nation. We express our deepest solidarity with students in Gaza, the West Bank, and all war-torn regions struggling to pursue education amid violence and chaos.

Therefore, IUSY resolves:

1. To recognize the right to education as fundamental, even—and especially—in conflict zones.
2. To call on international bodies to take immediate measures to protect students and educational institutions in Palestine and other war zones, in accordance with the Safe Schools Declaration and international humanitarian law.

5. To reaffirm IUSY's commitment to justice, peace, and the universal right to education, as a cornerstone of freedom and equality for all youth.

IUSY believes that there is no just world without free access to education and no peace without justice. Our solidarity with students under fire is not only political, but it is a moral duty rooted in our values as a global youth movement.
