IUSY condemns unequivocally and without reservation the fascist and brutal Israeli military operations across the occupied West Bank. In cities, villages, and refugee camps like Jenin and Tulkarem, Palestinian civilians are subjected to indiscriminate airstrikes, mass arrests, and large-scale invasions. Tens of thousands have been forcibly displaced, marking it as the largest mass displacement in the West Bank since 1967, as densely populated refugee camps are raided under the false pretext of "security operations." IUSY stands firmly against this collective punishment and demands an immediate end to these acts of organized state terror.

Alongside military aggression the Israeli occupation is violating the basic rights of movement and freedom, by using inhumane measures and psychological terror, with imposing an unlawful system of checkpoints, roadblocks, walls and artificial borders. These abusive policy of settlers colonialism obstruct movement between cities and villages, rips farmers from their lands, and denies students access to education. Over 806,000 Palestinian students have had their schooling impeded by occupation violence. Families are imprisoned within their own communities, workers are trapped in poverty, and economic life is suffocated at every turn. This systematic attack on the inalienable rights and dignity of the Palestinian people, Palestine's economy, and education is a systematic policy and calculated destruction of a people's ability to survive and resist.

In a parallel assault, the fascist Israeli government continues its piracy of Palestinian tax revenues, a deliberate act of economic warfare designed to cripple Palestinian governance. By withholding billions in cleared taxes, Israel forces civil servants into poverty, paralyzes healthcare, education, and public services, and deepens the humanitarian crisis. IUSY condemns this theft and demands the immediate, unconditional release of all Palestinian revenues, as mandated by international agreements and basic principles of justice.

At the same time, the Israeli government continues to illegally confiscate Palestinian tax money; a clear act of economic warfare meant to weaken Palestinian institutions and make daily life even harder. By withholding billions of dollars that belong to the Palestinian people, Israel is pushing civil servants into poverty, damaging healthcare, education, and public services, and worsening the

humanitarian crisis. IUSY strongly condemns this theft and demands the immediate return of all Palestinian revenues, as guaranteed by international agreements and basic principles of justice.

The cancerous spread of illegal Israeli settlements across occupied Palestine — including East Jerusalem — stands as the embodiment apartheid, land theft, and colonialism. Nearly 700,000 settlers live illegally in guarded colonies built atop stolen Palestinian land, while 3 million Palestinians endure military rule, segregation, and settler terror. These settlements, illegal under the Fourth Geneva Convention and denounced by the UN, are not merely obstacles to peace; they are evidence of ethnic cleansing. IUSY calls a complete halt to the settlement enterprise and urges for the immediate dismantling of all settlements and outposts, as a precondition for ending apartheid.

Nowhere is Israel's project of racial domination clearer than in Jerusalem. The campaign to Judaize the Holy City, through forced evictions, home demolitions, residency revocations and assaults on religious freedom, aims to erase Jerusalem's Palestinian identity. Indigenous Muslim and Christian Palestinians are besieged, displaced, and marginalized, while settler extremists seize homes and holy sites with the full backing of the Israeli regime. These apartheid policies flagrantly violate international law, including UN Security Council Resolution 478, which rejects Israel's unilateral annexation of East Jerusalem. IUSY stands in full solidarity with the Palestinian people of Jerusalem, and demands immediate international action to protect the city's rightful inhabitants and sacred heritage.

IUSY demands robust and tangible international accountability for Israel's crimes. We call for full and urgent support for the International Criminal Court (ICC) investigations into Israeli war crimes, apartheid, and crimes against humanity. We urge states to act on the forthcoming advisory opinion of the International Court of Justice (ICJ) affirming the illegality of the Israeli occupation. Concrete steps must follow: targeted sanctions, travel bans, and asset freezes against Israeli political, military, and settler leaders; visa bans against settlers illegally residing in occupied territories; and a total ban on goods produced in settlements. Companies and entities complicit in profiting from occupation must face economic isolation and legal prosecution. No apartheid regime should enjoy impunity.

IUSY calls upon all stakeholders worldwide to enforce3 solidarity actions with Palestine: through boycotts, divestment, mass mobilizations, and political pressure campaigns. The Palestinian struggle is not isolated, on the contrary it is a front line in the global fight against modern fascism, colonialism, racism, right wing and oppression.

We demand an end to military invasions, the removal of all checkpoints, the release of stolen revenues, the halt of all settlement expansion and the removal, and the full realization of Palestinian, inalienable rights, freedom and sovereignty.

The full attainment of the Palestinian people's right to self-determination, through the establishment of an independent Palestinian state, with Jerusalem as its capital.
